A Message from the Foundation's Past President

"We are only as strong as the communities we serve." It's a popular saying at Yeo & Yeo. Our culture of giving back started with the Yeo family. They believed it was vital to support the communities in which we live, work, and play.

Some of us were lucky enough to work with Lloyd Yeo, a third-generation family member and past President & CEO of the firm. Those of us who knew Lloyd saw firsthand his passion for supporting the community, and he was recognized with many awards for community service.

- In 1994, he received the Robert H. Albert Award of Community Service, presented by the Saginaw County Chamber of Commerce, an annual award recognizing a citizen from the region who has distinguished themselves over a lifetime through civic and professional achievements.
- In 1996, he received the Harry S. Lund Volunteer Award, presented by the United Way of Saginaw County.
- In 1998, he was awarded the Spirit of Philanthropy Award from the Saginaw Community Foundation.
- In 2002, he received the Delphi/Boys & Girls Club Award for Service to Youth.
- In 2008, the United Way of Saginaw County renamed the Community Involvement Award "The Lloyd J. Yeo Community Involvement Award" in recognition of his superior community service.

Lloyd passed away in 2008 at the age of 75, leaving a remarkable legacy of compassion and giving. It is his spirit of supporting others that shaped our firm into what it is today, and it is our job and honor to continue his mission through the Yeo & Yeo Foundation.

The Foundation gives each employee an opportunity to support organizations through volunteerism and financial gifts. This past year, we supported 60 organizations with \$150,066 in donations. I know Lloyd and the Yeo family would be proud. We have so much more to give, and I am excited to see how we will continue to make an impact in 2025 and beyond.

Therefore, all donation requests are submitted by Yeo & Yeo employees. When reviewing donation requests, the Grants Committee and the Foundation Board consider factors such as the mission and purpose of the requesting organization, the intended use of funds and the potential impact of the Foundation's support.

In the Foundation's fifth operational year, we gave back more than \$150,066 to 60 organizations across Michigan.
